

## Notes on Poster Session

The following instructions are for all the poster presenters.

### 1. Poster size and format

An area allocated to each poster display is limited to **0.9m (width) by 2.1m (height)** on the mounting panel stand that is assigned to you by your paper number. Your poster display may be a direct printout or a pre-integrated material on a large sheet of paper. Alternatively, you can mount several pages/figures on the panel in a neat and clean fashion.

You must prepare a separate sheet of paper **0.7m (width) by 0.15m (height)** which carries the paper number, the project title, your names and affiliations. This sheet should be put at the top of your poster display.

### 2. Where, when and how to set the poster?

Poster session is scheduled from **Wednesday, 8 to Thursday, 9 June at the foyer of theater.**

You can start your preparation from **9:30 Wednesday, 8 June.** Please keep in mind that you must complete the preparation **by 12:00, Thursday, 9 June.**

Tools for fixing your display on the panel, such as pins, paste or tape, will be provided at the poster session corner. You need to remove your poster display just after the presentation (after 20:00 Thursday). After 12:00 Friday, any materials left behind might be disposed without notice.

### 3. Core time for poster session

Presenters are requested to appear and stand by at the poster session corner at least during **18:30-20:00, Thursday, 9 June (CORE TIME)** to explain the poster and answer the questions from the participants.

### 4. Best Poster Award

**The best poster will be judged and voted by the participants. The ceremony of the best poster award will be held in Friday, June 10** at the Commendation & Closing Ceremony. **Please join the commendation ceremony not to miss this unforgettable moment!**

### 5. Etc.

As to submission of a PDF file, please refer to “Instructions for Authors ( both Oral and Poster Session ) ” on the ISTS web site. All authors of the Poster Session are also requested to submit a PDF file of their preprint. Please be aware that anyone who did not submit the PDF file will not be allowed to present the poster.
